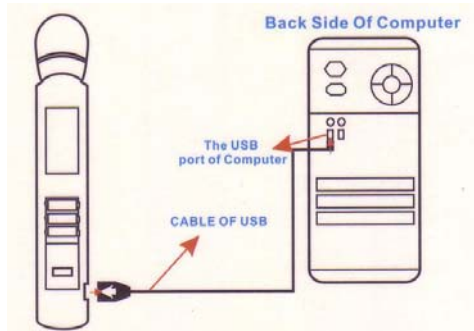

## INSTALLING THE USB DRIVER

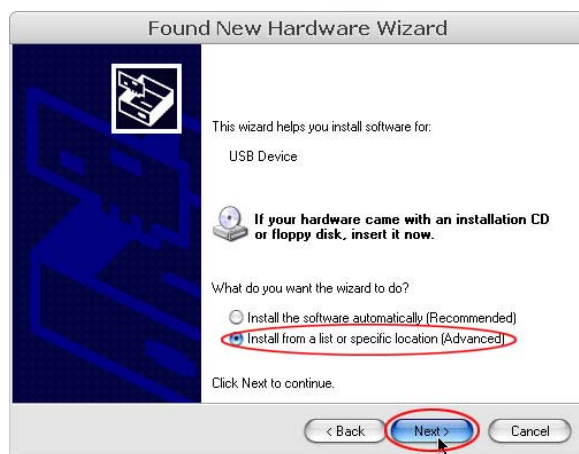
- Make sure that the main unit is plugged into an AC outlet or powered by fresh AA batteries.
- With your PC running, connect the supplied USB cable to the a free USB port on your PC. Place the Driver/Application CD on your drive.
- Connect the other end to your unit's MiniUSB port.



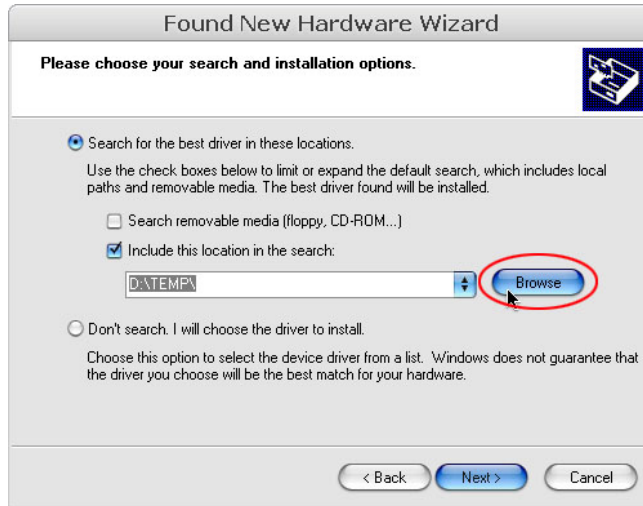
- Power on the main microphone.
- Your PC should detect the device and initiate the *Found New Hardware Wizard* dialog box.
- Click on the *No, not this time* radio button.
- Click *Next*.



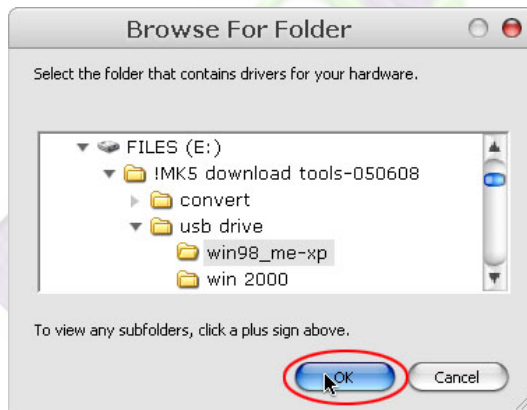
- Click on the *Install from a specific location (Advanced)* radio button.
- Click *Next*.



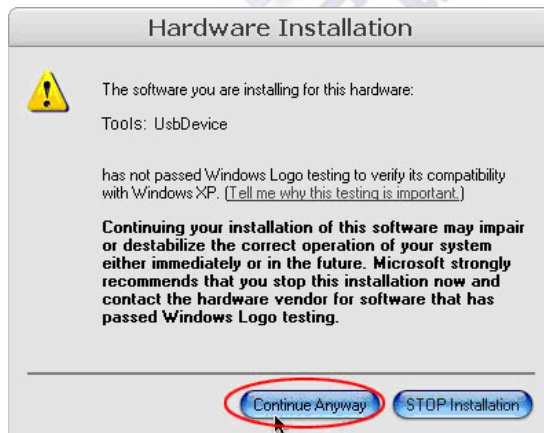
- Click on the *Include this location in the search:* radio button.
- Click on *Browse* button.



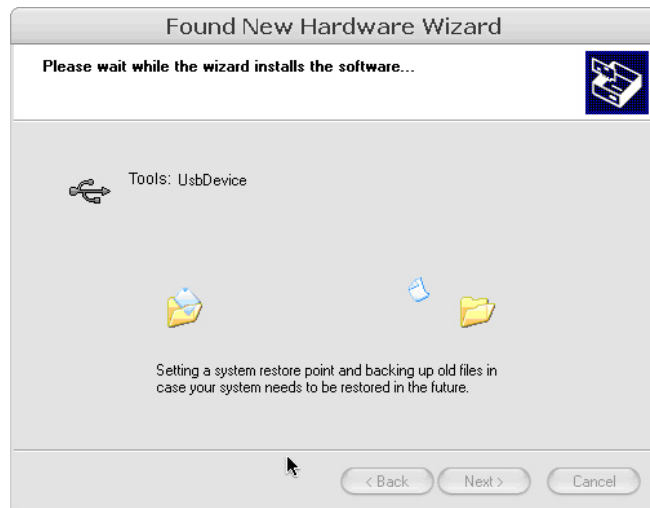
- Click your appropriate operating system. (Windows 95 and 2003 should use WinXP drivers.)
- Click *OK*.



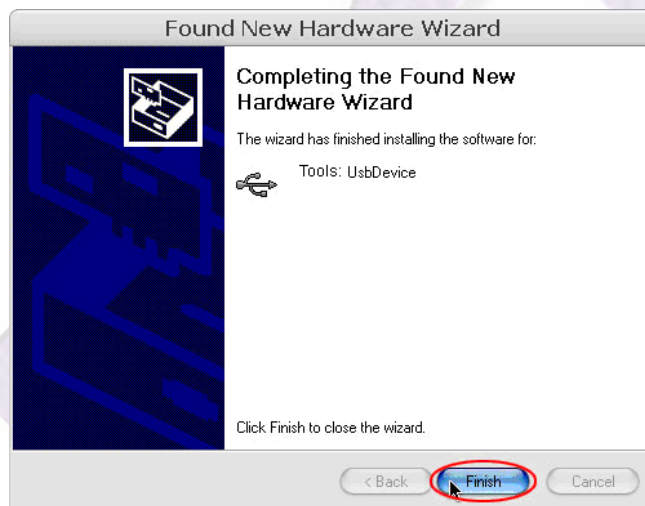
- An alert should come up warning you that the driver you are using has not passed Microsoft's HCDL test. Click on the *Continue Anyway* radio button.



- This should be followed by an animated dialog box as shown below.

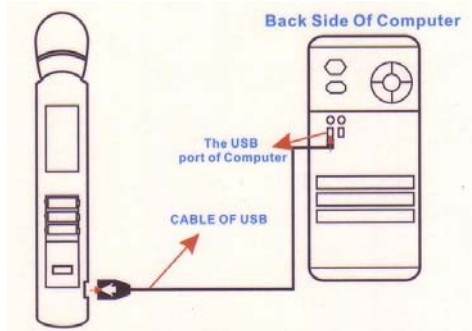


- Click on *Finish* to complete the installation.

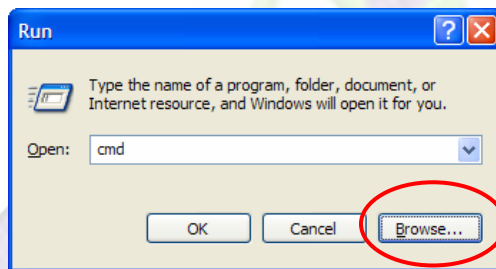


## UPLOADING SONGS TO MAIN UNIT

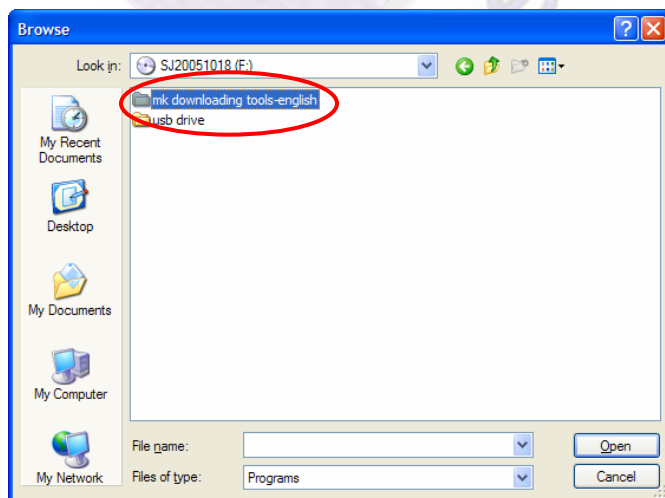
- Make sure that the main unit is plugged into an AC outlet or powered by fresh AA batteries.
- With your PC running, connect the supplied USB cable to a free USB port on your PC. Place the Driver/Application CD on your drive.
- Connect the other end to your unit's MiniUSB port.



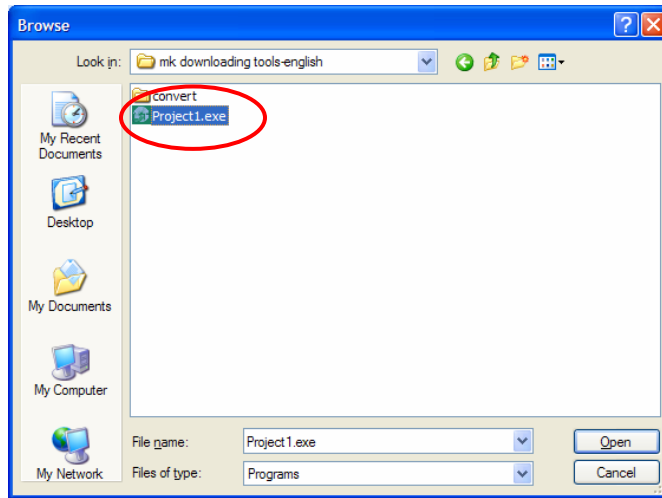
- Power on the main microphone.
- Click on **START/RUN** on your PC.
- Click on **Browse**.



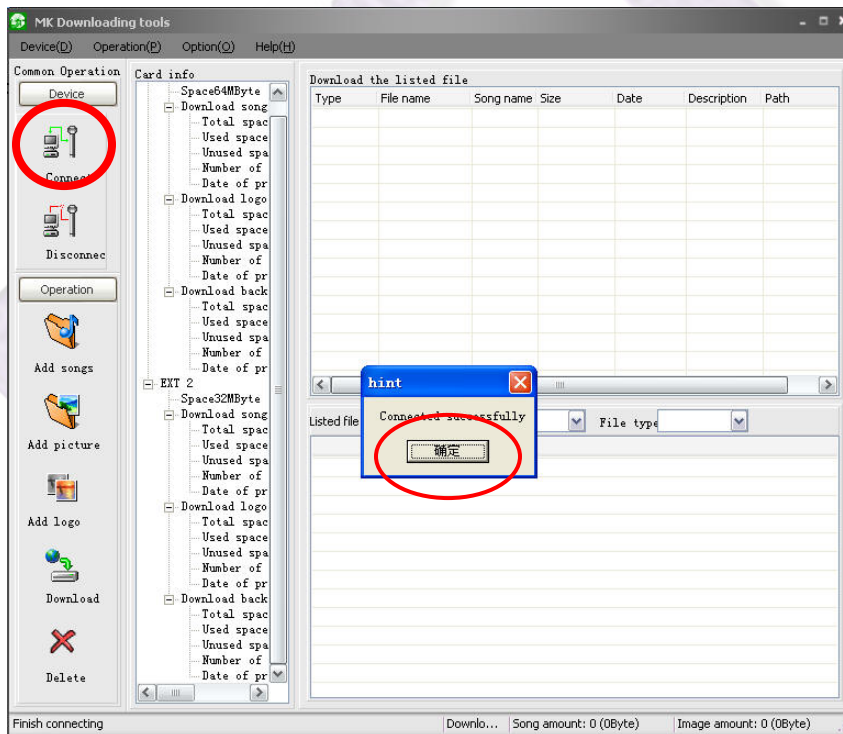
- Click on your CD/DVD drive.
- Double-click on the *mk downloading tools-english* folder.



- Double-click on *Project1.exe* application.



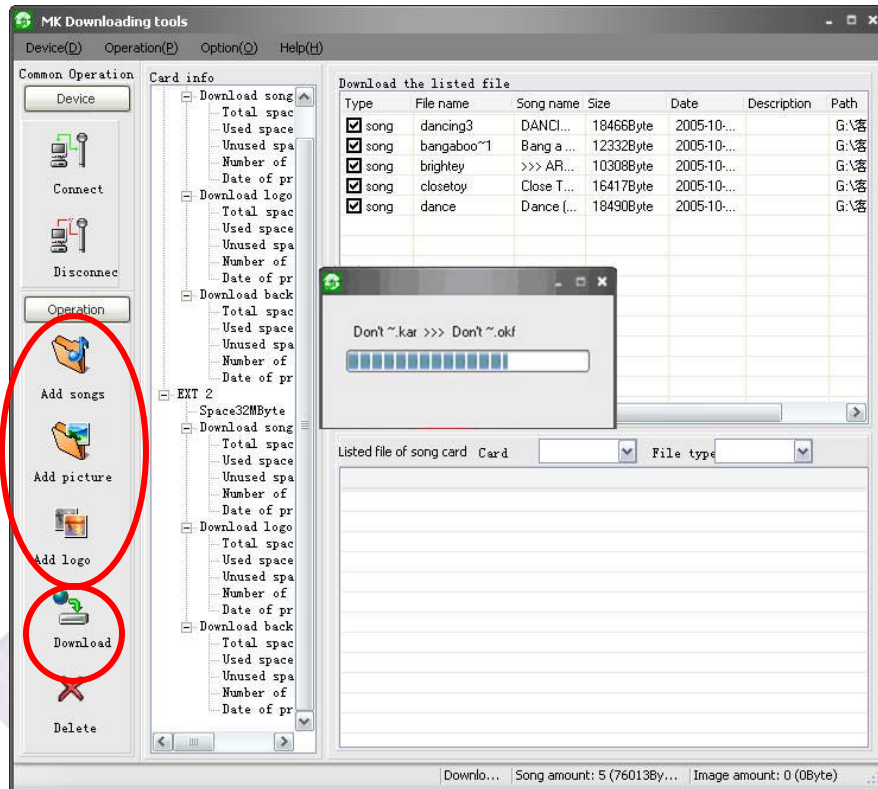
- This should open up the Download Application. Click on the **CONNECT** icon under the “Device” category.
- Click on **OK** on the Connected Successfully prompt box.



- Choose the desired download content – songs, picture (and videos), or logo.
- Please note that songs should be in .KAR format- Type 1 MIDI files with embedded lyrics. A lot of them can be found at [midikaraoke.com](http://midikaraoke.com) or similar sites. You may use the application included on our D&G Bonus CD to test them or you can just choose the songs from the same CD since it probably got more than what you can find on the net in 6 months. Or if you are our customer, you can go to our homepage at [www.dgcruz.com](http://www.dgcruz.com).



- For pictures, logos, and videos, they should be in MPEG 2 format at 352X240 resolution – the same one that they use on most cell phone videos. You may find free converters at [www.videohelp.com](http://www.videohelp.com). You can also find cool conversion stuff here such as creating MIDIs for later lyrics embedding.
- After completing your selection, click on **DOWNLOAD** icon. This will start conversion and transfer to the unit.
- Click on the **DISCONNECT** icon upon completion to make sure that download has completed before unplugging the unit.

TIPS: You can right click on items listed on either the list of files to be downloaded (top right) or the list of the files already on the unit's memory (bottom right) to show more options.
